**BC Triennial Convention:** Events at the convention were discussed and included the following concerns and suggestions:

- Delegates were concerned with the lack of business completed during convention. It was suggested that non-convention business such as workshops be held in the evenings. Although the political action workshop put on by the BC Fed was informative, many delegates had already attended the full day workshop "Talking Politics".
- It was also suggested to limit amendments from the floor as is done at some Component Conventions.
- It would be helpful for new delegates if an addendum with background information was included with the Financial Committee Report.
- Delegates were disappointed with work done by Resolution Committees (ie/ prioritizing resolutions / providing reasoning).
- There were some problems with convention facilities such as sound. In addition it was suggested that round tables be used instead of theatre style seating to facilitate discussion.

Agriculture Component provided funding to Local 20043 towards Regional Convention expenses. This money was used to compensate D-L. McKenzie (geographic delegate) for leave without pay taken on Friday April 8<sup>th</sup> and to pay the registration fee.

**Education:** D-L McKenzie reported that the "TUB / Understanding The Collective Agreement" course to be offered in Kelowna May 28<sup>th</sup> presently does not have enough registrants to proceed. The possibility of re-scheduling was discussed.

**- Action: D. Ringuette and S. Yaciw to survey members to see if enough registrants can be found and inform D-L McKenzie by April 13<sup>th</sup>.**

D. Ringuette indicated he would like to see training offered on the Public Service Modernization Act.

J. Leenhouts reported that CEIU has provided local officer training. The course was facilitated by J. Hennen and was excellent.

The need for a conference call with R. Brennen to discuss training needs for the area was discussed.

**Count Me In Campaign / Political Action:** D-L McKenzie reported that we have not spent the \$500 received from Regional Council for political action. Options were discussed and the following decided:

- donate \$250 to NDP candidate for Pentiction - Okanagan, Gary Litke. m/s/c
- donate \$250 to NDP candidate for Okanagan - Westside, Joyce Procure. m/s/c

**New PSAC Regional Rep:** Regina Brennan is the now the rep for Okanagan / Kootenay as well as the North. D-L McKenzie reported that Regina would like to make a field trip to the area and is looking for possible dates. Timing of the visit was discussed.

**Working With Other Rural Regions:** D-L McKenzie suggested that a request be sent to other rural regions to identify issues which we could work together on. A draft letter was circulated for discussion.

**- Action: K. Stanich, J. Harrison, S. Yaciw, and J. Leenhouts to provide feedback before letter is sent.**

**Women's Coordinator 1<sup>st</sup> Alternate:** Women delegates who attended the BC Regional Convention should be receiving nomination forms in the mail shortly.

**Action: J. Leenhouts to follow-up with C. Beynon to determine process to allow Darlene McGregor to be eligible for nomination.**
